COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection of material reflects Thomas Pfeiffer's involvement in the Lily White and Company drag troupe in Harrisburg, PA and The Pennsmen Inc., a group of LGBT people with a common interest in the leather/fetish lifestyle. The Marie Antoinette gown was worn by Thomas Pfeiffer during the Aug. 16, 1992 performance of *A Hystery of the World According to Lily*. The chain harness vest and leather spat spuds were handmade and worn by Thomas Pfeiffer.
